

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
July 17, 2006

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Monday, July 17, 2006, at 3400 S.W. Urish Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were H.J. Bromich and Bernie St. Louis. Also present were Dick May, Jr., Cathy Mosimann, George Schuler (3811 SW Friar Rd.), Michael Elliott (3821 SW Friar Rd.), Jerry Kingsley (6910 SW Fountaindale Rd.) and Gerald Block (6466 SW Suffolk Rd.).

H.J. Bromich called the meeting to order and moved for approval of the minutes of the June 2006 meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.

Bernie St. Louis moved for approval of the treasurer's report for the month of June 2006 and the following July bills for payment. The motion was seconded and carried.

Jerry Kingsley (Sherwood Lake Club) and Gerald Block (President, Sherwood Lake Club) came before the Sherwood Improvement District to discuss the sediment basin ramp and its need for modification. They requested that the district be a part of the solution of decreasing the silt on the ramp with regard to paying part of the costs. Bernie St. Louis suggested that the SID and the Lake Club split the cost of an engineering study for the project. Mr. Kingsley and Mr. Block will go to the Lake Club and get authorization for their portion of the engineering cost.

George Schuler and Michael Elliott discussed the water issue in the back of their properties on Friar Road. They indicated that the water stands after it rains and has been a continuing problem over the years. Dick will look for engineering shots down to the catch basin. No other action was taken.

Cathy is to send Bernie the minutes from March to June for the website.

Dick reported on the broken pipe caused by AT&T and a proposal he received from Roy Meyers to fix the pipe. He'll send a letter to AT&T.

Bernie St. Louis moved to approve the Road Repair Project for 2006 from Andrews Asphalt and Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$194,930.00 for the areas indicated by Dick. The motion was seconded and carried.
