

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
March 13, 2006

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Monday, March 13, 2006, at 3400 S.W. Urish Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were W.J. White, H.J. Bromich and Bernie St. Louis. Also present were Dick May, Jr., Cathy Mosimann and Len Richter of the Shawnee County Sheriff's Reserves Department.

W.J. White called the meeting to order and Bernie St. Louis moved for approval of the minutes of the February 2006 meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.

Len Richter reported that traffic enforcement has been increased due to the road construction and many tickets are being given. He also reported an increase in Shawnee County of house burglaries. The department would like to encourage homeowners to close their garage doors.

Dick May, Jr. reported the following:

-He's applied for a tax exemption certificate for the Gwaltney/Evans project. He let RL Myers know they were awarded the project and that he'd applied for the tax-exempt certificate.

-He took the speed limit sign issue for the district to Tom Flanagan. Mr. Flanagan indicated that federal guidelines state that a traffic study must be done to determine speeds in areas. In other words, 25 mph signs cannot be installed without this study. Without the study, the speed is automatically at 30 mph. He also was told that speed bumps are legal.

There was discussion about the Sherwood Improvement District and Mission Township website. It was decided to include the monthly district board minutes on the website.
