

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
November 13, 2006

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Monday, November 13, 2006, at 3400 S.W. Urish Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were W.J. White and H.J. Bromich. Also present were Dick May, Jr. and Cathy Mosimann.

- ✍ Lynn Couch is in agreement that it is not the responsibility of the Sherwood Improvement District or the Department of Public Works to maintain the silting basin located at 7405 SW Falcon Road. Dick's letter to the Sherwood Lake Club of October 22, 2006, confirms the Improvement District's position. After discussion, H.J. Bromich will give to the vice chair of the Sherwood Lake Club, Marcia Groth, paperwork regarding this issue.
- ✍ Because Roy Meyers is too busy to repair the broken pipe at the Westar station, Dick will check around to see if someone else is able to do the work.
- ✍ There was discussion regarding extending the fencing around the water tower area to enclose two areas and make them less accessible from 41st Street.
- ✍ Discussion on 2006 road project. After talking with Andrews Asphalt today, they indicated they'd get to the work this week.
- ✍ The work on the silt in the ditch at 41st and Indian Hills Road is complete.
- ✍ Tabled work on George Schuler's property until next year.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
